CPC 8th Annual Photo Competition/Exhibition

Buddhist Temples: Vancouver

Two Buddhist Temples are built in Richmond (Vancouver), BC, Canada. First in Buddhist Cultural Centre in Steveston Street, and the second in 5th Ave, Steveston, just a few minutes from the first.

These are the most magnificent traditional Chinese architecture in North America, which are visited by a big number of tourists from different countries worldwide. Different traditional ceremonies hold in these two temples, including Chinese New Year.

Fine symmetric architecture, different levels of the ceilings, curves of the ceilings, dragon shapes of the beams, gold and red colors of the buildings and tiles... remember us the magnificent of the Chinese Emperor's Palaces. These buildings, made of metal structure, are a combination of traditional Chinese architecture and Western technology.

A collection of artworks, including sculpture, water color painting, calligraphy and wood engraving, are gathered in these temples. Seven pictures of Buddha, painted on tiles, 26 meters height, are the largest in the world. Golden sculpture of 10,000-hand 10,00-eye (Badhisattva Avalokitesvara) is among this magnificent collection. This architecture, along with Chinese and Buddhist

ceremonies are worth to be seen. Some tours are available at the temples.

CPC had its outing on October 11 at the both temples.





Lynne R. Kelman, one of the jurors had some ideas on CPC competition:
