



Art in Dark

Leyla Mohammadi

This article is the selected part of my note on my exhibition during the solo exhibition on last spring. All photos were taken at night and I was moving direction to direction, zoom in and out and eventually editing with Photoshop.

Night photography could give you awesome photos, especially when cityscapes are lit with a myriad of interesting and colorful light sources, such as neon signs, store windows, and car lights. Night photography is a slow process; to create great nighttime shots, you will require a long exposure. In addition, all digital cameras and lenses have a difficult time with autofocus in low light, so you need to switch your lens to manual focus.

Timing

Half an hour before and after sunset is the best time for night photography. I tried at dark and dusk but at dusk, colors and details are easier to capture.

Quality

If you want the best night shots, you need to shoot in the best image quality, and that means RAW, which gives more flexibility editing: white balance, colour temperature, increase or decrease your exposures...

Using a tripod

Make sure your tripod is set up correctly. Any slight movement can make your photos blur.

Don't touch your camera!

When taking long exposures at night, even touching your camera to press the shutter button can create enough movement to leave you with blurred results. Use your digital camera's built-in self-timer, instead of pushing the shutter.

A lens hood

To minimize lens flares from light entering at angles outside of your frame.

Have Spare Batteries On Hand

Long exposures and cold weather can quickly drain camera batteries. Make sure to carry spare batteries.

Focusing in the dark certainly requires some careful patience, practice and check. There's nothing more frustrating than returning home and finding that half of your photos are out of focus, which is happened to me a lot. Eventually just make sure that your focus point is sharp.


You can see my photo, before and after edit in Photoshop. I used just simple tools which you can see in below.

Image - Adjustment - change the color temperature with color balance then, change the saturation and at the end, Filter - liquefy - Twirl you are done! Pleaes look at the picture in next page.



How to create your little planet in Photoshop?

I'm going to give you an instruction to make your planet step by step in Photoshop.

First of all, you need to have a photo with very straight horizon and a few objects like building or trees: Vertical & Horizontal Lines

The right end and the left end are going to connect to each other, so we need to have a pretty straight horizon, to have a quiet circle. When you choose your image, go to "Image Size" and take the dimension, which is less than the others and make height and width exactly the same.

- Then go to "Edit": Transform > Flip Vertical; now sky is on the bottom and the objects on the top.
- Go to "Distort" > Polar ordnance, then press OK.
- Now your tiny planet is effect here, with round sky around the photo

Then

go to smooth the line on the center select the line and then make a right click –choose Feather 5-10 pixels.

Go to "Filter" > Blur > motion and angle of zero.

Now flip the image back over (flip vertical back)

If you want really get ride of that, and to have perfect

circle and symmetry, you could copy one side and copy to other side; but I don't recommend it.





Select the photo and then go to: Image > Adjustment > HDR Toning Now change the settings that suit to your photo! (Note: Settings would be different for deferent photos)

Shadow % +1 Highlight % -75 Vibrancies %


